

Dr. Theodoros Tsakiris is an Assistant Professor at the University of Nicosia specializing on the geopolitics and economics of hydrocarbons. In March 2014, Dr. Tsakiris was appointed as a Member of the Board of Directors in the *Cyprus Hydrocarbon Company*, the National Oil & Gas Company of Cyprus. He is also directing ELIAMEP's Energy Programme and it is in this capacity that he participates in the HORIZON 2020 [FU.TU.RE.](#) project for the study of Turkish-European Relations. From January to June 2010 Dr. Tsakiris worked with the *Office of the Deputy Minister for Energy of Greece* as a special scientific advisor focusing on international oil & gas projects. In 2008-2009 he served as the *Head of the Policy Making Unit* at the *Special Secretariat for International Energy Policy* of the *Hellenic Ministry of Development*.

Dr. Tsakiris also held policy-making research & advisory positions in the Greek Parliament's Foreign & Defense Committee, the Greek Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Greek Ministry of Defense through the Defence Analyses Institute. He is the author of 3 monographs and 31 book chapters and articles in English and Greek including publications in peer-reviewed journals such as *Comparative Strategy, Foreign Affairs (Hellenic Edition), Perceptions, Journal of Energy Security, Agora Without Frontiers, Journal for Southeastern Europe & Black Sea Studies, Mediterranean Quarterly, and Journal of Comparative Management*. Dr. Tsakiris' work has been cited in academic publications prepared for and published by, *George Washington University, King's College London, the Geopolitics of Energy Project of the Belfer Center for Science & International Affairs of Harvard University* and the *Energy Initiative Program of MIT*.
