

H.E. Dan Mihalache, Ambassador of Romania to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

Mr Mihalache was appointed as the Ambassador of Romania to the Court of St. James's on the 8th of June 2016. Prior to this, he held the position of the Head of Presidential Chancellery and the Head of Presidential Administration for almost two years. Mr. Mihalache has broad political experience, having led numerous political, policy and communications campaigns on behalf of the National Liberal Party (between 2009 and 2014) and of the President Iohannis in 2014. Between 2004 and 2008, Mr. Mihalache served a complete term as Member of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies, while in 2006 and 2007 he held a seat as Observer Member and then as Member of the European Parliament (MEP). He is a graduate of the Bucharest University Law School (1994) and the Romanian National Defence College (1998), and has a PhD in political science (2008).
