

**Mr. Constantin Ionescu** (born 1956), graduated the Airspace Faculty of the Polytechnic University of Bucharest and worked as an engineer and scientific researcher at the Bacau Aircraft Company, the National Institute of Thermal Engines, INCREST, COMOTI SA (1982-1992).

Between 1992-2000, he was a member of the Romanian Parliament. He held the position of Secretary of the Defense, Public Order and National Security Committee (1992-1996). Mr. Ionescu occupied the position of Secretary of State, as a member of the Cabinet, and Minister of National Defense (1996-1998), as well as Minister of Home Affairs (1999-2000).

He has been a member and has collaborated with various non-governmental organizations in the field of public policy as well as security and defense systems. He graduated the National Defense College (1994) and the Defense Resources Management Institute (USA, 1995). He holds a management degree at Open University, Open Business School (UK, 1993).
