

**Mr. Emanuel Plopeanu** is Associate professor of History at Ovidius University of Constanța, Romania. He received his B.A. and M.A. degrees from Ovidius University of Constanța and his Ph.D. degree from Al. I. Cuza University of Iași. His main area of scientific interest regards international relations in South-Eastern Europe in 20<sup>th</sup> century, with special expertise on the US-Turkey relations, on the cold war in the Black Sea region and in the Balkans. Emblematic are his studies on the US policy in South-Eastern Europe and the regional diplomatic developments in the interwar period.

As Dean of the Faculty of History and Political Science of Ovidius University, he has strongly supported the strengthening of the political science programs, particularly in the area of security and soft diplomacy in the Black Sea basin and in the Balkans.
