

**Mr. Mihai A. Gîrțu** is Professor of Physics at Ovidius University of Constanța, Romania. A graduate of the University of Bucharest with an M.Eng. degree in Applied Physics, he received the Ph.D. degree in Physics from the Ohio State University, USA. His research interests focus on the physics of materials with applications in hybrid photovoltaics, molecular magnetism, photocatalytic degradation, and, more recently, in biomedical technologies.
