

Mr. Sorin RUGINĂ is Professor of Infectious diseases in the Faculty of Medicine, the Ovidius University of Constanța, Romania. A graduate of the Carol Davila University of Medicine and Pharmacy in Bucharest, he is a medical doctor and a Ph.D. in medical sciences, with extensive expertise in infectious diseases and epidemiology. His research interests range from various forms of HIV and hepatitis to more exotic infectious diseases originating in tropical countries.

In the past, he held the position of general manager of the Infectious Diseases Clinical Hospital of Constanța presently being the Rector of Ovidius University of Constanța. He is a member of two prestigious scientific and honorary bodies, the Romanian Academy of Medical Sciences and the Romanian Academy of Scientists. For his outstanding contribution to HIV/AIDS research, he received the USAID award of excellence, whereas in recognition for his service to public health he was awarded by the President of Romania with the high distinction of Knight of the Order of Medical Merit.
