Prior to joining Lockheed Martin international as Vice President for Europe and Americas on 3rd February 2014, Jonathan was Director General for Government and Industry Cyber Security. He was a member of the GCHQ Board and the SIRO (Senior Information Risk Owner), responsible for industry engagement, the Information Assurance agenda at GCHQ, the development and delivery of a national IA (Information Assurance) capability in the cyber context.

In May 2009, Jonathan took up a temporary appointment as Director General Commercial at the MOD. Before that he was Chief of Staff in Defence Equipment and Support where he was a member of the Main Board, responsible for governance, performance management, secretariat and strategy.
