

Mr. Constantin IONESCU, state advisor, Presidential Administration, Romania

Constantin Ionescu graduated the Faculty of Aircraft within the University Politehnica of Bucharest. In this field, he worked as engineer and scientific researcher at Aircraft Factory Bacau, The National Institute of Heat Engines, INCREST, COMOTI SA (1982-1992). In 1992-2000, he was member of the Chamber of Deputies, the Parliament of Romania, activating as secretary of the Committee for Defense, Public Order and National Security (1992-1996). In addition, he held the position of state secretary, member of the Government, respectively Minister of Defense (1996-1998) and Minister of Internal Affairs (1999-2000). Constantin Ionescu was member and he collaborated with different nongovernmental organizations, in the field of public policies as well as security and defense systems. He graduated the National College of Defense (1994) and the Defense Resources Management Institute (SUA, 1995).
