

## **Doru Lionachescu, Board Member of Banca Transilvania**

Mr. Doru Lionachescu, 54, is a Board Member (independent, non-executive) of Banca Transilvania, Romania's 2nd largest bank, listed on Bucharest Stock Exchange (ticker TLV). He is also a Board Member (non-executive) of BT Capital Partners, the investment banking subsidiary of Banca Transilvania. For both Board positions, Doru Lionachescu has been approved by the respective regulator, National Bank of Romania and the local Financial Supervision Authority. BT Capital Partners was created in 2016 after the acquisition by BT Securities (the former brokerage arm of Banca Transilvania) of Capital Partners - an investment banking boutique whose Founder and Principal Partner was Doru Lionachescu. By the time of the transaction with Banca Transilvania Financial Group, Capital Partners was Romania's leading independent investment bank having advised since inception in 2006 on more than 2 Billion EURO of deals across its main business lines: M&A Advisory and Corporate Finance.

Before starting Capital Partners in 2006, Doru Lionachescu spent almost 11 years in various top management positions in the banking sector, starting with ING Bank, then as Vice president Citibank N.A. and later as Deputy CEO of Bancpost, the 5th largest local bank at the time. His specialization is wholesale banking, including corporate and investment banking, capital markets, corporate risk management and related activities. Before starting his banking career, Doru Lionachescu was one of the leading financial journalists of the country lately as Deputy Chief Editor of Capital, Romania's main economic publication at the time.

Doru Lionachescu holds an Executive MBA degree from ASEBUSS, a joint program set up by the University of Washington, Seattle and the Academy of Economic Studies Bucharest. He also holds an MSc in Electronics and Telecom from the Politechnical Institute Bucharest.

Doru Lionachescu is an active presence in the Romanian mass-media, writing and commenting regularly on various economic, financial and geopolitical topics, and being often invited on TV and radio shows as a representative of the Romanian business community.
