Cătălin Moraru is a graduate of the Technical Military Academy of Bucharest, in the field of Radio Electronics Air Defense Missiles, and also of the National School for Administration and Politics, Public Administration. From 1984, after receiving the academic degree, he chose his assignment as technical Officer in Air Defense Regiment and until 1992, he was instructor in the Training Centre and maintenance officer in Air Defense HQ. From 1992 he started a 25 years activity in Armaments Department starting from contracting officer, program manager, deputy chief of Contracting Directorate and deputy chief of the Armaments Department with a huge experience in major armaments programs management, national defense research and developments projects planning and coordination, testing and evaluation activities, validation and acceptance. From 2009 until retirement in 2017 he was deputy chief of the department and in this period was in charge as full chief three times for a cumulate period of 5 years.

He was promoted as a brigadier-general in 2009, in 2011 as a major-general and in 2017 as a Lieutenant-general.

In 2014 Cătălin Moraru completed his doctoral studies on electronics with a thesis about solutions for radar cross section reduction.
