Mr. Mihnea Ioan Motoc is a Romanian diplomat who served as Minister of Defence of Romania between November 2015 and January 2017. Before this appointment, he was the country's ambassador to the EU, UN, and the country's ambassador in London. Currently, he is the deputy head of the European Political Strategy Centre, the in-house think tank of the European Commission. (currently rebranded as IDEA - Inspire, Debate, Engage and Accelerate Action- I.D.E.A. is an advisory service that provides innovative ideas and a unique space for interdisciplinary research and collaboration on core Commission priorities. It accelerates ideas for concrete action and reports directly to the Commission president.)

Mr. Motoc has been a Romanian diplomat since the early 1990s, when he joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Romania. For most of the 1990s Motoc spent time in various Romanian government posts.
