Mr. Nelu Tătaru is the Minister of Health of Romania since March 2020, after holding a State Secretary position in the Ministry of Health since November 2020. Following the graduation of the University of Medicine in Iași, Mr. Tătaru held various positions in the healthcare system, since first starting his medical career in 1991 as a resident physician until becoming the manager of the Municipal Hospital of Huși. Between 2012-2016, Mr. Tătaru was a member of the Senate, in the Romanian Parliament.

Following the completion of medical education and training including a PhD in medical sciences, Mr. Tătaru also graduated from the Romanian Diplomatic Institute, the Romanian National Defence College and other post-graduate degrees.
