Since 2019, Mr. Vlad Nistor is a Member of the European Parliament serving in the Committee on Foreign Affairs. He is a Romanian historian and a professor at the University of Bucharest. Mr. Nistor also holds a PhD in History from the University of Bucharest and has done his postdoctoral studies in British Cultural Studies at Warwick University, UK.

Mr. Nistor has followed an academic career, starting as an assistant professor (1986-1991), lecturer (1991-1997), associate professor (1997-2001) and professor since 2001. He has also published various volumes and articles in the field.

Between 1998 and 2000 he has served as a presidential advisor. In 2004, Mr. Nistor was chosen as Dean of the Faculty of History at the University of Bucharest where he remained in office until 2012. In 2005 he was also named Executive Manager of the Institute of Romanian Diplomacy. Between 2012-2016, Mr. Nistor was a Representative in the Romanian Parliament.
