Gordan Grlić Radman was born on 6 June 1958 in Tomislavgrad, Bosnia and Herzegovina.

He served as different positions and especially as the Ambassador of the Republic of Croatia to the Federal Republic of Germany from October 2017 to July 2019. Before, he worked as the Ambassador of the Republic of Croatia to Hungary from 2012 to 2017.

From 2011 to 2014, he was Secretary of the Danube Commission.

Gordan Grlić Radman studied Engineering in Agricultural Economics, in Management Studies and in the field of international relations.

In 2007, he defended doctoral dissertation “Neutrality and the New European Security Architecture” at the Faculty of Political Science, University of Zagreb.

In 2010, he was appointed to the academic grade of research associate at the same university.
