

Ovidiu Alexandru Raeţchi

Ovidiu Alexandru Raeţchi is the President of the Euro-Atlantic Center for Resilience, holding State Secretary rank. He was the vice-chairman of the Defense, Public Order and National Security Committee in the Chamber of Deputies. Mr. Raeţchi also represented Diaspora (2012-2016) and the city of Bucharest (2016-2020) within the Romanian Parliament.

He is a writer and historian with expertize in the Middle East and the Black Sea region. A graduate of political science (SNSPA) and security studies (in Bucharest and Garmisch-Partenkirchen), he has a double master's degree – in Arab culture and Jewish civilization. In the second half of the year, Mr. Raeţchi will defend his Ph.D. thesis in history on mediating the peace process between Egypt and Israel through back channel; and another Ph.D. thesis in political science regarding the Muslim Brotherhood.
