Terry 'T.J.' Jamison is the Director of Autonomous Aviation and Technology. Based in Mesa, AZ, he leads the Business Development team for domestic & international Autonomous Aviation & Technology (AA&T).

Jamison joined the company in November 2016 as the Vertical Lift International Sales Senior Manager responsible for Boeings vertical lift portfolio around the globe; he then moved into a Director role for Boeing Global Services Vertical Lift and Special Operations. Previous to Boeing he completed a successful 30-year career as a U.S. Army Aviation Officer. He commanded an Air Cavalry Squadron in Iraq and a Combat Aviation Brigade in Afghanistan. During both combat deployments he supported U.S. Army and Coalition forces with AH-64 Apache and CH-47 Chinook helicopters.

He retired from military service as a Colonel with more than 5,000 flight hours in Army helicopters including the AH-64D Apache Longbow and CH-47 Chinook. In his final assignment, T.J. served as the Chief of Staff for the U.S. Army Aviation Center of Excellence in Fort Rucker, AL.
