Ana Revenco has taken over the security portfolio since August 6, 2021, being appointed as Minister of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova.

She served as adviser to President Maia Sandu in the field of national security, as well as secretary of the Supreme Security Council.

Being an expert and international trainer on fighting human trafficking and related crimes, she served as executive director of the International Centre "La Strada Moldova", a non-governmental organization focused on human rights.

Revenco served as head of the Centre for Combating Trafficking in Human Beings of the General Police Inspectorate (GPI).
