

## Colonel Daniel Cocolici

## Deputy Director for Analysis Romanian Military Intelligence Directorate

He graduated the Polytechnic Institute of Bucharest (Master in petrochemical engineering) in joint program with "*The Military Technical Academy*" and University of Bucharest (Master in security studies).

He also attended several other military training programs to include: British-Romanian Training

Center (Command and Staff Course, Brigade level) and Command and Staff College (post graduate course) at the National Defense University; National Intelligence College (post graduate course) at the National Intelligence Academy.

He started his military career at the Joint Logistic Command and continued at the General Staff Logistic Directorate fulfilling various positions involving logistic planning, infrastructure development and international activities.

As of 2000, he joined the Military Intelligence and Representation Directorate providing expertise in fields like scientific and technical intelligence and political-military analysis, eventually becoming Chief Analyst.

Colonel Daniel Cocolici served as Deputy Defense Attaché of Romania to the United States of America (2002 - 2006) and as Defense, Military, Air and Navy Attaché of Romania to the State of Israel (2010 – 2014).

On January 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, he was appointed Deputy Director for Analysis.
