

Ylva Johansson (born 13 February 1964) was appointed European Commissioner for Home Affairs in December 2019. From Sweden, she was minister for Employment in the Swedish Government from 2014 to 2019, minister for Welfare and Elderly Healthcare from 2004 to 2006 and minister for Schools from 1994 to 1998. She has held key positions in the Swedish parliament as Deputy Leader of the Social Affairs Committee and the Labour Market Committee. She has also worked for Telia Business Innovation, the education company Att Veta AB and as a teacher.
