

## **Adam Eberhardt**

Deputy Director of the Centre for East European Studies at the University of Warsaw (SEW UW).

Dr. Adam Eberhardt is Deputy Director of the Centre for East European Studies at the University of Warsaw (SEW UW) and a distinguished political scientist with a PhD in international relations. A leading expert on Polish foreign policy and regional dynamics in Central and Eastern Europe, his research focuses on the European Neighborhood Policy, post-Soviet international relations, and the internal and external policies of Russia, Ukraine, and Belarus.

From 2016 to 2022, he served as Director of the Centre for Eastern Studies (OSW) in Warsaw, following eight years as its Deputy Director, and previously held senior research and leadership roles at the Polish Institute of International Affairs (PISM), including as Head of Research and Senior Fellow. Earlier in his career, he worked as Chief Correspondent of the Polish News Agency PAP in Moscow. Between 2022 and 2024, he was Vice President of the Warsaw Enterprise Institute and Director of its Center for Strategic Studies. In the realm of public service, Dr. Eberhardt was the Polish Prime Minister's Plenipotentiary to Support Reforms in the Republic of Moldova from 2020 to 2024 and currently co-chairs the Polish-Czech Forum, established by the foreign ministers of both countries. He is a member of the Foreign Policy College advising the President of Poland and has been appointed as an OSCE expert on the human dimension mechanism for the 2023–2029 term. In 2022, he served as advisor to the President of Ukraine in the Working Group on International Security Guarantees for Ukraine.

Deeply committed to education and policy dialogue, Dr. Eberhardt has lectured at the Diplomatic Academy for aspiring Polish diplomats and has been invited to speak at academic institutions and think tanks across Europe, America, and Asia. He also serves on the editorial board of the *Polish Diplomatic Review*. In recognition of his contributions to public service and international affairs, he was awarded the Knight's Cross of the Order of Polonia Restituta by the President of Poland in 2015.
