Benjamin Haddad is a French political figure and international affairs expert with extensive experience in diplomacy, transatlantic relations, and European policy. He currently serves as Minister Delegate to the Minister for Europe and Foreign Affairs, responsible for Europe, a role he assumed in December 2024 after previously holding the same portfolio under the Prime Minister and Minister for Europe and Foreign Affairs from September to December 2024.

From 2022 to 2024, he served as a Member of Parliament for Paris's 14th constituency (16th arrondissement), where he was actively involved in foreign policy and European affairs. Prior to his entry into elected office, he held senior research and leadership roles in prominent international think tanks. He was Europe Director at the Atlantic Council in Washington, D.C. from 2019 to 2022, and a Research Fellow in International Relations at the Hudson Institute from 2014 to 2018.

He is a graduate of both the Institute of Political Studies (Sciences Po) Paris and HEC Paris (École des Hautes Études Commerciales), bringing a blend of academic rigor and practical experience to his work in public service and international diplomacy.
