

Ms. Daniella Misail-Nichitin, Minister of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova

Ms. Daniella Misail-Nichitin is the Minister of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova, appointed in November 2024. Born on September 25, 1976, in Chisinau, she has a strong background in human rights, gender equality, and combating violence and exploitation. She holds an Oxford Executive Leadership Programme certification (2024) and has extensive training in areas like human rights, gender-based violence, and child sexual exploitation from international organizations such as the IOM, ECPAT, and the World Bank. Ms. Misail-Nichitin holds Master's degrees in Advocacy and Social Change and Non-profit Organization Management from CREDO Moldova and graduated in Law from the Academy of Economic Studies of Moldova.

Her professional career includes leadership positions at the International Center "La Strada", where she served as Director of Women's Programs (2015-2021) and President (2012-2015). Prior to becoming Minister, she was State Secretary at the Ministry of Internal Affairs from 2022 to 2024.

Fluent in Romanian, Russian, and English, Ms. Misail-Nichitin is also a co-author of over 15 publications on human trafficking and violence prevention. As Minister, she continues to focus on enhancing security, justice, and the protection of vulnerable groups in the Republic of Moldova.
