

Ambassador Fatih CEYLAN

Ambassador Fatih Ceylan is the President of the Ankara Policy Center (APM), a leading think tank in Türkiye focused on foreign and security policy. A career diplomat, he joined the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1979, serving in key posts including Ambassador to Sudan, Ambassador to NATO, and Deputy Undersecretary for Bilateral Affairs.

He has represented Türkiye in various international missions, including NATO, the EU, and postings in Islamabad and Deventer. Ambassador Ceylan holds a Master's degree in International Relations from Rutgers University, with additional studies at Princeton University.

He was honored by Sudan and Kazakhstan for his contributions to bilateral relations. Now retired from diplomatic service (as of 2019), he writes and speaks extensively on NATO, European security, and Turkish foreign policy.
