Hassane Saoudi is a retired Colonel of the Royal Gendarmerie of Morocco, currently serving as Consultant and Director of Securi-Consulting. Over the course of his distinguished military career, he held several key leadership roles, including Chief of Studies and Legislation at the Royal Gendarmerie Headquarters, Commander of the Royal Gendarmerie Training Center in Marrakech, and regional command posts in Kenitra and Meknes.
