

Michael Georg Link, European and Transatlantic Affairs, Friedrich Naumann Stiftung, Germany

Michael Georg Link was a Member of the German Bundestag (MdB) from 2005 to 2013 and again from 2017 until early 2025. Between 2014 and 2017, he was Director of the OSCE Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) based in Warsaw. Since October 2023, he has been Deputy Chairman of the Free Democratic Party (FDP) parliamentary group in the Bundestag, responsible for foreign affairs, security, European policy, human rights, and development policy. From March 2022 to November 2024, he served as the German Government's Coordinator for Transatlantic Cooperation at the Federal Foreign Office. In addition to his parliamentary work, Michael Georg Link is a member of the federal and state executive committees of the FDP and serves as Deputy Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Friedrich Naumann Foundation for Freedom.
