

Michael MIKLAUCIC, Senior Fellow, Irregular Warfare Center, USA

Michael Miklaucic is on the Academic Faculty of the University of Chicago, and the Oswaldo Aranha Chair Professor at the University of Sao Paulo. In 2024 he retired from a four-decade career working with and for the United States government with assignments at the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), the Department of State, and the Department of Defense. At USAID he served as Chief Operating Officer of the Center for Democracy and Governance; at the Department of State, he was Deputy for War Crimes Issues; at the Department of Defense he was a Senior Fellow at National Defense University where he was a founding member of the Center for Complex Operations, the founding Editor-in-Chief of the PRISM journal, and editor of seven books on national security-related issues. He currently serves as an advisor to the Ecole de Guerre in France, the Institute for State Effectiveness, the Irregular Warfare Center, and as a Fulbright Expert at the Center for the Study of Democracy in Sofia, Bulgaria. He was educated at the University of California, the London School of Economics, and the Johns Hopkins School for Advanced International Studies.
