

## **Anca Dragu** - Governor of the National Bank of Moldova

Anca Dragu is a Romanian economist, public official, and current Governor of the National Bank of Moldova, a position she has held since December 22, 2023, after being appointed by the Parliament of the Republic of Moldova. She is the first woman to serve in this role.

Dragu previously had a distinguished career in Romania and internationally. She served as Minister of Public Finance of Romania from 2015 to 2017 and was President of the Senate of Romania from December 2020 to November 2021, becoming the first woman to hold that office. She has also been a member of the Senate of Romania.

Earlier in her professional life, Dragu worked in the financial sector, including as an economist at the National Bank of Romania and as an economist for the International Monetary Fund. She also served as an economic analyst and advisor within the European Commission.

Dragu holds a bachelor's degree and a PhD in economics from the Bucharest University of Economic Studies and a master's degree in public policy and European integration from the National University of Political Studies and Public Administration. She also completed postgraduate studies in international economics at Georgetown University in the United States
