

Florian Ciolacu has been the Executive Director of the Romanian Farmers' Club since September 2018.

Florian Ciolacu was the Commercial Vice President of Romania's most prestigious software company, SIVECO Romania, specializing in complex software projects. He was part of the SIVECO team for eleven years.

Previously, he served as a diplomat at the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, focusing on relations with the UN and Multilateral Diplomacy. He was appointed as the Romanian representative to the specialized agencies in Geneva (2000–2004) – the International Telecommunication Union, the World Intellectual Property Organization, and UNCTAD – and as a representative to the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN).

In 2006, he completed the Executive Policy Program at the J.F.K. School of Government, Harvard University.
