

## **Jean Valvis** - founder of Valvis Holding

Jean Valvis is a Swiss-Greek entrepreneur and founder of Valvis Holding, a Romanian-based group of companies active in the food and beverage industry, agriculture, and wine production. Through Valvis Holding, he developed several well-known brands in Romania, including the premium mineral water AQUA Carpatica and the wine brand Domeniile Sâmburești.

Valvis began his entrepreneurial activity in Romania in the early 1990s and built successful businesses in the mineral water and dairy sectors, creating brands such as Dorna and LaDorna before later launching AQUA Carpatica in 2010. As founder and CEO of Valvis Holding, he oversees a diversified portfolio of companies involved in mineral water bottling, wine production, agriculture, and international distribution.

Established in the 1990s, Valvis Holding operates in the fast-moving consumer goods sector and manages companies such as Carpathian Springs, which produces AQUA Carpatica, and Viti-Pomicola Sâmburești, which produces wines from the Domeniile Sâmburești vineyards. The group's products are sold in Romania and exported to numerous international markets.
