Maia Otarashvili is the Vice President of the Delphi Global Research Center and a specialist in Eurasian geopolitics and security. She previously served as Program Director for Eurasia at the Foreign Policy Research Institute (FPRI), where she led research and analysis on regional security dynamics and foreign policy developments.

Her research focuses on the geopolitics and security of the Black Sea–Caucasus region, Russian foreign policy, and post-Soviet conflicts, particularly in Georgia, Moldova, and Ukraine. She is also co-editor of the volume *Does Democracy Matter? The United States and Global Democracy Support* (2017), published by FPRI.

Otarashvili holds an MA in War Studies from King's College London and an MA in Globalization, Development and Transition from the University of Westminster, with a focus on post-authoritarian transitions.
