

## **Major General Mircea Gologan - Deputy Chief of Defence for Resources, Romania**

Major General Mircea Gologan serves as Deputy Chief of Defence for Resources of the Romanian Armed Forces, a position he has held since December 23, 2024.

A top graduate of the “Nicolae Bălcescu” Military Officers School (1990), he also completed the National Defence University in Bucharest as valedictorian and holds a PhD in Military Sciences. He further enhanced his education through numerous NATO and international courses, including at the NATO School in Oberammergau, the NATO Defense College in Rome, and the European Security and Defence College in Brussels.

With a military career spanning over three decades, he has held a wide range of command and staff positions, including platoon, company, battalion, and brigade commander, Director-level roles, and Deputy Commander of an Army Corps. He has also served within NATO structures, including at NATO Headquarters and the Allied Command Transformation.

Major General Gologan has participated in multiple international missions, including in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Afghanistan, where he served in senior leadership roles, including as Romania’s Senior National Representative.

He has been awarded numerous Romanian and international distinctions, including the Order of Military Virtue and U.S. military decorations such as the Bronze Star Medal and the Army Commendation Medal, in recognition of his leadership and service.
