Martin Ängeby is a Senior Analyst at the European Centre of Excellence for Countering Hybrid Threats, where he focuses on resilience, democratic governance, and countering hybrid threats affecting Europe and partner countries. He contributes to policy analysis, strategic assessments, and international cooperation initiatives related to security and institutional resilience.

He has extensive experience in democracy support and political development. Prior to joining Hybrid CoE, he served as Senior Country Director in Moldova for the National Democratic Institute, leading programs aimed at strengthening democratic institutions, political participation, and governance reform.

Mr. Ängeby previously served as Secretary-General of the Swedish International Liberal Centre, a nonprofit organization supporting democracy and human rights globally. He has also worked with the International Institute for Democracy and Electoral Assistance and in regional planning in metropolitan Stockholm, with a focus on social integration and public policy.

An experienced political strategist and campaign manager, he has held leadership positions in several international organizations, including Chairman of the International Elections Studies Centre in Lithuania and former Chair of the European Network of Political Foundations (ENoP).

Mr. Ängeby studied sociology and political science at Lund University and Universidad Complutense de Madrid. He is also co-editor of the publication *Dialogue for Democratic Development* and has contributed to multiple works on democratic dialogue and governance
