Oleksandr Danylyuk is a Ukrainian statesman, economist, and business leader, currently serving as President of Destinus, an innovative aerospace and defense technology company. He brings extensive experience from both high-level public service and international finance to his leadership role.

Danylyuk previously held key positions in the Ukrainian government, including Minister of Finance of Ukraine (2016–2018) and Secretary of the National Security and Defense Council in 2019. Before entering public service, he built a successful international career in investment banking and consulting.
