

Radu-Dinel Miruță – Minister of National Defence, Romania

H.E. Radu-Dinel Miruță (born 8 April 1985) is a Romanian politician and engineer, currently serving as Minister of National Defence of Romania since December 2025, after initially holding the position in an interim capacity starting in November 2025.

He also serves as Deputy Prime Minister, bringing together experience in government, parliament, and the technology sector.

Mr. Miruță previously held the position of Minister of Economy, Digitalisation, Entrepreneurship and Tourism from June to December 2025, where he contributed to policies aimed at economic modernization and digital transformation.

He has been a Member of the Romanian Parliament (Chamber of Deputies) since December 2020, representing Gorj County and serving on committees related to communications, information technology, and economic affairs.

Before entering politics, Mr. Miruță built a professional career as a telecommunications and software engineer, working with major international companies such as Cosmote, Ericsson, and Cisco. He holds a PhD in telecommunications from the Politehnica University of Bucharest, where he also completed his undergraduate studies in electronics and telecommunications.

A member of the Save Romania Union (USR), he is recognized for his expertise in digital infrastructure, cybersecurity, and technology-driven public policy.
