

Dr. Paul Coyer is a historian and foreign affairs and national security specialist whose career spans the private sector, government, and academia. His unique background includes strong relationships across civilian-military and public-private sectors as well as with key partners in Europe, the Middle East, Asia and Latin America. He is founder and President of The Coyer Group, an international advisory firm; Senior Advisor to American Strategic Metals; a Venture Partner with Iron Gate Capital Advisors, where he sources investments in dual-use technologies supporting U.S. and allied national security; and co-founder of a firm placing critical minerals into U.S. and allied industrial supply chains.

He has spoken twice in the past year in the Romanian Parliament: on Romania's strategic positioning in a rapidly shifting geopolitical environment, and on U.S.–Romanian investment and business ties, for which he led a panel of U.S. and U.K. business leaders. Dr. Coyer has held academic appointments at l'École Spéciale Militaire de Saint-Cyr and the Rennes School of Business (France), and is currently a Research Professor at the Institute of World Politics in Washington, D.C. His analysis has been published in Forbes, the Kyiv Post, Il Giornale, Revue Conflits, and by National Defense University Press and Oxford University Press. While living in Shanghai he edited a book on the Shanghai Stock Exchange (published jointly by JP Morgan and the South China Morning Post), and his book *L'Etica del Nazionalismo* was published in Italy in 2020.

He holds three graduate degrees from Yale University and the London School of Economics and Political Science.
