Alexandru Petcovici is the Infrastructure Director of Proger Global Network in Romania. A civil engineer specialised in road infrastructure, he brings over a decade of experience that bridges both sides of Romania's infrastructure ecosystem: nearly 14 years on the beneficiary side at CNAIR's Regional Roads and Bridges Directorate Cluj, followed by his current role on the contractor side, where he oversees major projects including the A0 North Bucharest Ring Highway under the Pizzarotti–Retter consortium.

He is a member of PIARC Technical Committee 1.1 — Road Administration Performance — within the World Road Association, contributing to the international benchmarking of road authorities.

His expertise covers FIDIC contract frameworks (Red, Yellow and Silver Books), Romanian public procurement and construction law, road design standards, and infrastructure dispute resolution.
